- At the start, line up according to your pace with faster runners to the front. This will allow participants to get into their pace at the start of the event.

Start

START LINEUP

We ask that participants line up at the starting line based on their pace. This means that faster runners will start first followed by walkers. We will be releasing waves of runners to limit course crowding. Please listen for your estimated pace and start during that time.

Timing

We will use ChronoTrack timing technology. To get an official race time and be included in results, participants MUST wear a bib number with timing device on front of body so they can be validated at the finish on camera.

Course

The course will follow the route listed below. There will be one aid station passed at Mile 1 and 2 and will provide Water + Gatorade. Participants will have 1 hour to complete the course.

TURN BY TURN

- Start at Rose Park on Edgehill Ave.
- Exit Rose Park onto Edgehill Ave and turn Right
- Edgehill Ave to 16th Ave S. turn Right
- Right on Music Circle S.
- Left on Music Circle N.
- Right on Music Square E.
- Enter Demonbreun St. Roundabout and turn Left onto Demonbreun St.
- Turn around at 14th Ave. S
- Enter Demonbreun St. Roundabout and turn Left on Music Square E.
- Left on Music Circle N
- Right on Music Circle S
- Left on Music Square E/16th Ave S
- Left on South Street to first Villa Place
- Right on Villa Place
- Right on South Street
- Left 16th Ave S. (Music Square East) to Edgehill Ave
- Left on Edgehill
- Edgehill Ave to Rose Park at Start/Finish Line



Finish

The Finish Line is in the same place as the Start Line.

FINISH LINE FESTIVAL

Once you cross the finish line you will receive your finisher medal, water, and an iced towel. Proceed to the refreshment tent for Gatorade, bananas, granola bars, and POPSICLES! Please bring a reusable hydration pack to help us cut down on event waste.

RESULTS

Official results can be found at the Packet Pickup tent located in the festival area. Stop by the booth to see your time and to print out your finisher information. It will show your time and finisher place.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented 3-deep in the divisions below for both male and female categories. You will only be allowed to claim a prize in one category. Awards must be picked up at the event and will be given out within 30 minutes of the last eligible winner crosses the finish line (approx. 8:15-8:30 am).


